

In the future I plan much longer reports, I am just getting started.





# Secretary's Minutes – David Pounds

#### **Membership Meeting Minutes**

December 12, 2023

Members present: Andre Montgomery-President, Scott Maas-Vice President, Dave Pounds-Secretary, AJ Kupka-Treasurer, Julie Montgomery-Membership Director, Shawn Hanna-Tech Director, Jan Hanna-Past President, Joel Meyer-Editor

Andre called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Board Member Reports:

President-Andre called for "The Pledge of Allegiance" and proceeded to read off all of the nominations for the 2024 board members. After a name was read for each board position, he asked the members if anyone wanted to nominate another member for that position. After the 7 nominated members were announced by Andre, none of the members at the meeting nominated another member. Andre then asked for a motion to approve the new board members, and the membership approved the motion. Our choices were the Chanhassen Dinner Theater, the Treasure Island Casino, and the Southview Country Club. The Southview Country Club in Saint Paul was by far the best choice, and the costs were very reasonable. Andre told the members about this beautiful Country Club and the excellent location. I also want to take this opportunity to thank Andre and Julie for meeting me and my wife Nina at all three of these places. Their expertise, questions, and advice really helped us come to a final decision. Also, I want to thank John and Jane Wessel for suggesting the Southview Country Club. We really appreciate the help.

Andre made a motion to approve the November minutes, Julie Stulz approved the motion, Shawn Hanna seconded the motion, and the membership approved the motion.

Vice President-Scott thanked Keri Kuechle for setting up the Spring Banquet Luncheon at the Next Chapter Winery in New Prague on May 19, 2024. This venue can seat up to 130 members,

The members really enjoyed them.

There were 77 members at our November meeting, and two guests (Bob Elfering and Bob Sagen), and both of them joined our club. Membership is officially open for 2024, and the cost of \$60 has not gone up. An application is not needed for current members unless your address, email, or phone number has changed. 
